BVU also provides education and training, volunteer referral and organizational consulting services to over 900 nonprofit organizations annually.

As Managing Director, Leadership Development, Ms. Clark provides consulting, training, and management assistance services to strengthen the governance and management of nonprofit organizations. She also oversees BVU's board matching program, which prepares, trains and matches professionals for positions on nonprofit boards of directors.

Prior to joining BVU in 2007, Ms. Clark was the Public Relations Manager at The Cleveland Orchestra. In that capacity, Ms. Clark managed all aspects of public relations campaigns for The Cleveland Orchestra, Severance Hall, and Blossom Festival, including planning, style, and content of messages for communication with media. She also coordinated overall promotion and marketing of special Cleveland Orchestra community concerts and events, including the annual Public Square and Martin Luther King Jr. celebration concerts, and managed the Orchestra's volunteer Community Relations Committee.
